

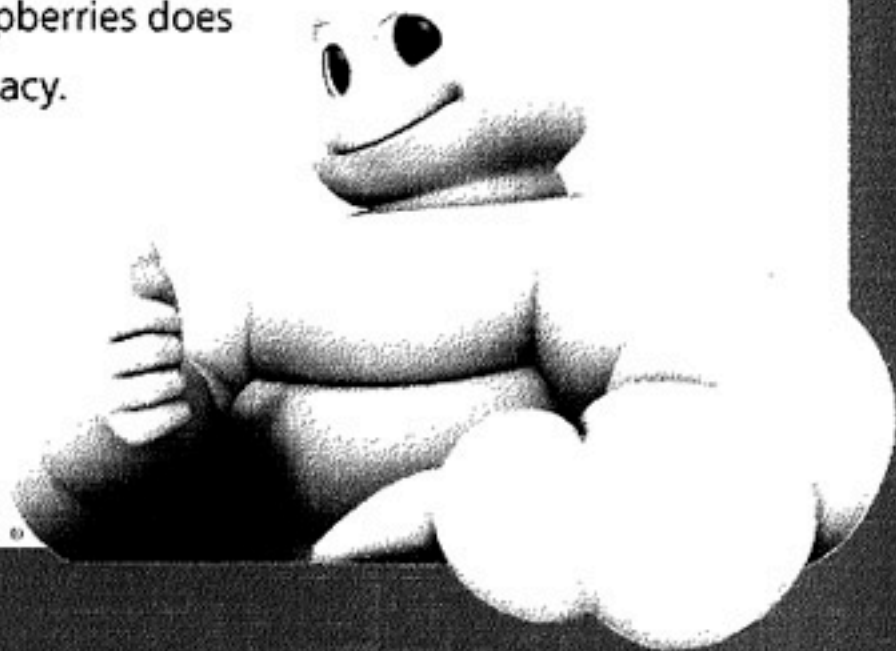
2010 MICHELIN GUIDE RECOMMENDED

Sister to the Left Bank Brasserie located at the opposite end of Santana Row, LB Steak is a good fit for this tony mixed-use complex. At lunchtime, the patio is the place to be for local business folks to sink their teeth into gourmet burgers and steak sandwiches. In the evening, couples and shoppers stop by for brawny USDA prime steaks and elegant seafood. Dishes get a soupçon of French sophistication courtesy of Chef/proprietor Roland Passot.

When it's time for dessert, look to the pastry cart for more refined offerings than the usual steakhouse sweets. Among the cookies, financiers, and fruit tarts, a raspberry *macaron* filled with vanilla pastry cream and scattered with plump, sweet raspberries does justice to the restaurant's French legacy.



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
